The French Revolution and Napoleon (HS 315 core or/and ML 300 level)

Paris trip: May 22 to June 4, online class until June 11, 2022.
(includes one free weekend, (Saturday afternoon and Sunday) breakfast plus one meal per day)

Instructor: Dr. Andrew Ross, History Department

Additional support: Dr. André Pierre Colombat, Office of International Programs

Travel with Dr. Ross and Dr. Colombat: an on-site exploration of the history of the French Revolution (including Versailles; the Louvre; the Bastille and Concorde squares; the Tuileries gardens; the Pantheon, Napoleon's Tomb; the Arc de Triomphe; and much more)

- Required 2 online Pre-course orientation meetings
- Course includes **fourteen-day trip, 12 nights) to Paris, France.** Departure: May 22- Return: June 4, 2022, plus on-line follow up sessions until June 11, 2022,
- Participants must be ready to walk for site visits every day. Bring comfortable walking shoes
- Cost: tuition, Paris stay and visits (including breakfast every day, one free Saturday afternoon and Sunday, dinner every day, lodging (12 nights), subway, activities and visits included
- Not included: airfare, one meal a day, personal expenses
- **Three-credit course** fulfills requirements for second History core and/or ML 300 level course for French minors or majors
- **This course is entirely taught in English. No French required.**
- Minimum required cumulative GPA 2.5; no serious disciplinary record
- **Applications and \$500 deposit due (reimbursed if program has to be cancelled by Loyola (see * below))** - first come first served until February 15, 2022.
- *** minimum enrollment: 12 participants**
- **Cost: \$3,850 (without airfare)**
